

THE WALKING WATER EXPERIMENT

What to do :

SEMAS

- Place 7 cups in a row and pour in 1/2 a cup of water in the 1st, 3rd, 5th, and 7th cup.
- 2. Add a drop of food colouring/ waterproof paint in the cups with water and stir using the spatula.
- 3. Take a half sheet of paper towel and fold it in half lengthwise and place it in the cups
- 4. You should quickly be able to see the colored water begin to crawl up the paper towel.
- Leave for about 3 4 hours and you will see the magic of the water mixing as a rainbow.

Ingredients:

- Food colouring or waterproof paint (4 different colours)
- 7 clear plastic cups
- Spatula
- A jug of water
- Stirring Rod
- Paper Towels
